- 1. The meeting is organised by East Ayrshire Car Club and will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA). These Final Instructions form part of the Supplementary Regulations and should be read in conjunction with these and any further instructions or bulletins issued by the club.
- 2. Kames is situated just off the A70 in Muirkirk, East Ayrshire. It is 13 miles west of J12 on the M74 and 10 miles east of Cumnock. The full address is: **Kames Motorsport Complex, Furnace Rd, Muirkirk, East Ayrshire, KA18 3QQ**
- 3. All drivers have the same competition number and paddock space on both Saturday and Sunday.
- 4. The paddock will be open from 4:00pm on Thursday afternoon and 07:00am on Saturday and Sunday mornings.
- To ease congestion, please ensure your trailer is moved to the trailer park asap.
 The paddock will be busy, so it will not be possible to park support vehicles beside your competing car in all cases.
