CAR SHOW

East Ayrshire Car Club can now accept entries for their second classic show at Kames, this year with sponsorship from Club member Tom Coughtrie's Creative Classics, an Ayr company supplying and fitting upmarket kitchens.

Classes have been modified in line with numbers entered in each class last year. With a more ambitious programme, our budget has been increased, with more tents (at least one offering shelter in adverse weather), a pipe band, more toilet facilities and wider publicity. It is hoped to have a parade lap again, probably one for each class, these spread over a longer period.

To speed up arrival and documentation, we are introducing two entry points, one for private entrants at the first gate, with Clubs' cars using the main gate. Clubs may, if they so wish, assemble in or near the village and enter the site together in order to get their cars into position more quickly. More details will appear in the Final instructions to be issued 7-10 days before the Show.

By issuing these regulations well in advance of the closing date for entries we are giving ample opportunity for owners to meet our deadline. This policy was necessary in order to make documentation and judging more efficient.

Finally, it will help greatly if an email address can be supplied by owners, as this is the fastest method of communication.

East Ayrshire Car Club built Kames Motorsport Complex in 1984 and the track is used for Sprints, Rallies and Autotests.

For the last two years British Cycling have coached junior racing cyclists at Kames and in April they held a very successful meeting with ten races of varying lengths for different age groups. Over 80 cyclists from all over the West of Scotland attended and it is hoped to hold more meetings in the near future.

Two universities use Kames as part of their engineering courses for students and one major car manufacturer has tested tyres and other components there as part of their World Rally Championship campaigns.

Kames is where the late Colin McRae had his first rally outing and where his dad and brother Alistair have entertained rally enthusiasts on many occasions with their spectacular driving.

Profits from the Show will be used to improve the Complex facilities; the immediate project being a major development of the Clubhouse which will considerably increase the usable area.

Please remember, the Closing Date for entries is 14th July and numbers are limited to 250 cars.

East Ayrshire Car Club will organise a Classic Vehicle Show at Kames Motorsport Complex, Muirkirk, Ayrshire on Sunday 2ndrd August 2015.

Vehicles may be entered for judging in one of the following classes:

1. Veteran. Vintage and Post Vintage up to 31/12/1959
2. Classic Cars 1960 - 31/12/1964
3. Classic Cars 1965 - 31/12/1969
4. Classic Cars 1970 - 31/12/1974
5. Classic Cars 1975 - 31/12/1979
6. Classic Cars 1980 - 31/12/1984
7. Classic Cars 1985 - 31/12/1989
8. Classic Cars 1990 - 31/12/1994
9. Classic Cars 1995 - 31/12/1999
10. Future Classics (GT/Sports/Luxury Cars) after 1/1/2000
11. Kit Cars
12. Competition Cars.
13. Novelty Vehicles

Classes may be amalgamated in the event of less than four entries received.

Additional classes may be introduced.

Judges will be appointed by East Ayrshire Car Club and their decisions will be final. Should any Club/Group wish to hold judging within their Club/Group in addition to the general judging, that Club/Group must provide the additional trophies and judges.

Owners may trailer their vehicles but this must be stated in the entry form to help the organisers plan layouts, etc. Trailers must use the Trailer Park and marshals will try to site the trailing car as near as possible. No vehicle may share the space allocated for an exhibit without the advance approval of the organisers.

There will be an owner Entry Fee of £4.00 per car to cover programme, awards, etc.

Clubs may apply for a group area in the Paddock. Owners may enter their vehicle as part of a Club/Group or as an individual car and must state their preference on the entry form.

Clubs will be allowed a small area for shelter and to publicise their activities. Application must be made on the official entry form. Any Club or individual wishing to erect a tent, awning or gazebo, etc. must state so on the entry form and must ensure they have appropriate public liability insurance in place.

Autojumble stands will be accommodated at a charge of £10.00.

A Speed Limit of 5mph will be strictly applied at all times and only drivers holding a full driving licence and appropriate insurance cover may drive within the site. The use of cycles, mopeds etc. (other than mobility carriages) will not be permitted.

Owners must arrive and sign-on between 9.30 a.m. and 10.30 a.m. when they will receive their display number, programme, etc. Each owner will receive their final instructions and be told their official number one week in advance of the Show, preferably by email. Entrants are asked to supply an email address to reduce the workload.

The closing date for entries will be 14th July, when the entry list will go to the printers of the Official Programme. Any car not in the Official Programme will not be judged.
