

EAST AYRSHIRE CAR CLUB – September 2020 AUTOTEST

1. The East Ayrshire Car Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans permit, **Autotest** on Sunday 20th September, at Kames Motorsport Complex.
2. The meeting will be governed by the general regulations of Motorsport UK Ltd (incorporating the general provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the promoting club may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK Permit Number:
Autotest: 118901
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, and invited clubs.
5. All competitors must have both a current Motorsport UK competition licence and a club membership.
6. The programme of the meeting will be:
Scrutineering will start at 10:00.
First run starts at 11:00 PROMPT.
7. The event will consist of 2 classes as follows:

Autotest	
Class 1	saloons up to 1400cc
Class 2	saloons over 1400cc, all specials & sports cars
8. All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK technical regulations (J, M16, 17, 18).
9. The following regulations are modified:
 - J5.4.1 Forced induction coefficient will not apply.
 - M17.1 Vehicles need not be registered or taxed.
 - M17.2 Light commercial vehicles are permitted in appropriate classes.
10. There is no limit to the number of times a car maybe entered but it must be driven by different drivers on each occasion. A driver may not enter to drive more than two cars. When a competitor enters more than one car, he/she must nominate which entry is to count towards the championship(s).
11. Awards will be presented as follows:
 - Fastest time of the day
 - First in each class
 - No competitor may win more than one award
12. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations on the East Ayrshire Car Club website and closes on Friday 17th July.
13. All entries must be made using the on line system which can be accessed via the club web site, www.eastayrshirecc.co.uk/autotests.
14. The entry fee for the event is £20.00
15. Payment options are BACS and PayPal via the online entry system.
16. All entries remain provisional until payment has been received by the club.
17. The maximum entry for the meeting is 20 and the minimum is 10. The minimum for each class is 3.
18. EACC reserve the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the event if the minimum numbers are not reached
19. EACC reserve the right to refuse entries without giving a reason.

21. Entries will be accepted as follows - first 15 accepted.
22. Entry fees may be refunded for entries withdrawn before entries close.
23. Entries withdrawn after entries close will have refunds made at the discretion of the club.
24. In the event that the event is abandoned or postponed, entry fees will be refunded.

26. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event.
27. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5.
28. Details of the tests will be provided by email in advance.
 - The slowest run from each test will **NOT** be counted.
 - Timing will be by stopwatch.
 - The starting signal will be verbal.
 - Order of attempting the test will be at the organiser's discretion.
 - Practising will not be permitted.
29. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by email by the organisers.
30. Marking and penalties will be printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General regulations except as modified below.
31. Marking and penalties will be as printed in Section M Table M.7 of the MSA General regulations except as modified below.
 - Table M.7 (c) Not performing test properly - slowest time in Class + 20 marks
 - Table M.7 (d) Striking a pylon, barrier or wall or crossing boundary of test + 5 marks.
 - Table M.7 (e) Failing to cross or stop at any line or specified position + 5 marks.
 - Table M.7 (e) Failing to stop at a Baulk line + 10 marks.
32. All other general regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written, except for the following which are modified.
 - M14.2 Pylons may be less than 1m high.

Anyone speeding or driving in a reckless manner WILL BE EXCLUDED

33. The event will be run in line with the applicable guidance and regulation from the Scottish Government and Motorsport UK and its interpretation and application by EACC, with regards to the current Covid-19 pandemic. The following will be applied:

- No spectators
- A maximum of one other individual accompanying each competitor
- Shared vehicles must be disinfected by the competitors between runs, if applicable
- Social distancing must be adhered to at all times
- Paddock spaces will be marked out to support social distancing
- Any mandatory competitor PPE and personal sanitation must be self-supplied
- The clubhouse will not be open for competitors
- Please take the residents of Muirkirk into account when arriving and leaving Kames

The club will rely on the cooperation of all competitors and them being responsible for their own actions during the event.
